



SeaCamp Information



SeaCamp is a week long trip to San Diego, California to visit a marine biology camp. Activities include snorkeling, aquarium visit, boogie boarding, tide pooling, and a variety of lab activities. Students stay at SeaCamp in large dormitories and are supervised 24 hours a day. The upcoming trip will be October 2nd-6th, 2017. The opportunity is available to all students attending Creighton Middle School for the school year 2017-2018. **The cost of the week includes all meals, accommodations, activities, supervision, transportation, and sponsor expenses (substitute for the week, transportation and meals).** The price of airfare varies greatly and as a result, the cost may change in the fall if airfare increases significantly. We have worked with the same travel agent for the past few years and she has secured fair prices for us. Because we are traveling as a school group, all students must travel on the same flight. In order to do this, I handle all flight arrangements and airfare purchases. You may come across a good one time deal on-line, but when working with a large group, the same deals are not always a possibility. **This year's cost is \$1130.00 (\$720 camp tuition, \$410 airfare, airport transfers, & sponsor expenses).** The schedules of deposits for this trip are as follows:

\$150.00 due April 14, 2016 (non-refundable)

\$230.00 due May 12, 2017

\$400.00 due August 11, 2017

\$350.00 due August 31, 2017

***SeaCamp's cancellation policy is less than 30 days prior to our session date all tuitions are non-refundable.**

We will accept checks, MasterCard or Visa for your payment. All checks must be made out to Creighton Middle School. When mailing or dropping off funds, please mark the envelope Attn: Monica Keegan, SeaCamp. If paying with cash or credit, please see the Financial Secretary, Jennifer Swenson, to make your payment. After the first payment has been made, you will also be able to pay online through Jeffco Connect.

SeaCamp is open to all 7th and 8th graders who attend Creighton.

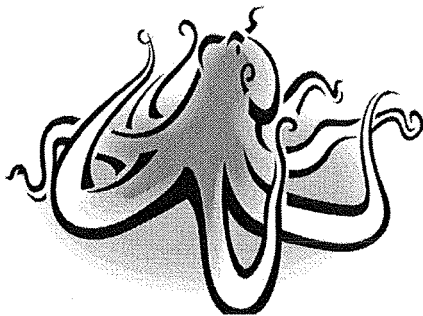
SEACAMP Marine Science Program
